



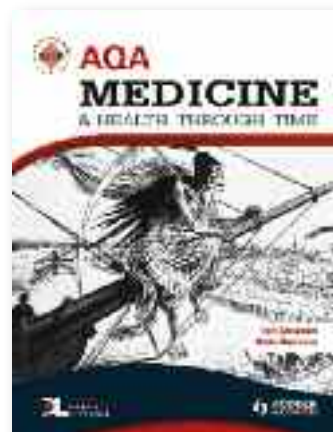

Smarter revision

We said earlier that revision can be fun. You probably didn't believe this but here's how to enjoy revision by thinking hard and being creative. The idea is to start up with Galen and think about what you've decided to create that own picture showing clearly why Galen was so important. This is how they did it:

- 1 They investigated Galen's work and compared a list of his individual ideas like the one on page 28.
- 2 They started thinking creatively – how could they turn that information into a picture that they could use to revise from? That's what led to this picture – each of the things you can see tells you about Galen's work.
- 3 The idea that the picture was associated with writing in a short explanation of what each object tells us about Galen.
- 4 They didn't see their thinking as Galen's thoughts. But we've taken off those notes and added them to your own. All the things you need to see pages 38-41 and the notes on page 43 will help you. You could even produce a summary picture of Galen's work yourself. How fun!

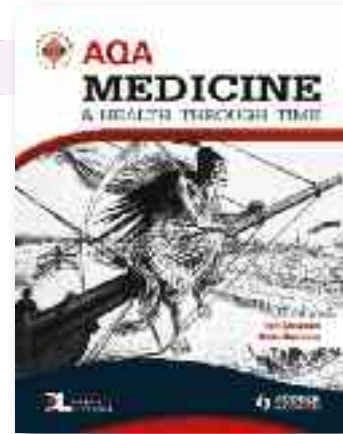
