

## PC Installation notes

**You are licensed to use Dynamic Learning (Student Edition) only at home. It is not to be installed in your school or educational establishment.**

**A Network Edition of most titles will be available for use within your school. Please check our website, [www.dynamic-learning.co.uk](http://www.dynamic-learning.co.uk), for details.**

**Dynamic Learning requires a broadband Internet connection in order to function. Please make sure that any security software on your PC allows the program to access the Internet. The program also requires write access to your computer, so you may need an admin account. See below for further details, or check [www.dynamic-learning.co.uk/faq](http://www.dynamic-learning.co.uk/faq) for frequently-asked questions.**

When you insert this CD/DVD-ROM, the Dynamic Learning splash screen should automatically launch. If it does not, please navigate to your DVD drive and double-click **Setup.exe**.

Launch the installer from the splash screen and follow the on-screen prompts. This will install **Dynamic Learning (Student Version)** to your PC's hard drive and place shortcuts on your desktop and in your Start menu (under **Hodder Education**). Make sure you have plenty of free space on your hard drive as some DL titles containing a lot of video can be quite big.

### Initial launch of the program

To launch Dynamic Learning, double-click **Start DL Student** on your desktop.

- You may be told that an update to the program is available and is being downloaded. The update will automatically download and install and the Dynamic Learning Engine will then launch.
- The first time you run this Dynamic Learning title, basic data about the title must be downloaded. This may take a few minutes, but only needs to be done once.
- News updates about this or related titles may be provided when you run the program. These are designed to keep you up-to-date with related resources that are available to help you with your studies.
- On-line tutorials are available to help you get the most from Dynamic Learning. To access the tutorials, click the **DL Tutorials** button at the top of the main Dynamic Learning window.

### Uninstallation

Should you wish to uninstall Dynamic Learning, please go to Start menu > Settings > Control Panel > Add or Remove Programs and pick both **Dynamic Learning (Student Version)** and **Dynamic Learning – [the name of this title] (Student)**. Please note that due to the way the program updates itself over the Internet, not all files will be removed. The files that remain do not affect the operation of your computer, but can be removed completely by navigating to **C:\Hodder Education\** and deleting the entire **Dynamic Learning (Student)** folder. Note that this will also delete any other DL titles you have installed.

### Technical hints

If Dynamic Learning cannot connect to the Internet, extra configuration of your security software may be required. Dynamic Learning requires access to the following domains. They are not all websites so a "page not found" error is not relevant:

All connections are via HTTP Port 80. It is not possible to configure Dynamic Learning to use a proxy server or a different port. It is unlikely that you will be able to use the Student Edition in your school; nor are you licensed to do so.
